Tips for planting a successful pollinator garden:

- Encourage adult butterflies to enjoy your garden by giving them places to rest like rocks and shrubs.
- Plant your garden in a sunny area that is protected from wind.
- Avoid the use of landscape fabric or thick bark mulch (leaf litter is ok).
- Drip irrigation is preferred, but overhead watering may be done at night.
- Avoid the use of pesticides.
- Leave plants standing for winter and don't remove fallen leaf litter.
- Provide a water source (fill a small bowl with sand or mud & keep it moist).
- Plan for continuous bloom throughout the season with a diversity of flower shapes.
- Group the same plants together.
